The following are the minutes from the **JUNE** meeting of the Administrative Church Council.

The minutes are available to help the entire church family stay in the know about how this group is caring for New Hope UMC!

Administrative Council Meeting Minutes - June 27, 2024

Present: Becky Breeding, Alicia Copeland, Cindy Deavers, Wanda Harding, Beth Howdyshell, Laura Jenner, Bill Lalla, Bruce Rogers, Cindy Sheets and Karen Whitmer.

The meeting was called to order by chairperson Becky Breeding, and Karen read a devotion and prayed.

The minutes to the May council meeting were accepted as distributed.

Treasurer: (Cindy Deavers reported)

- Our insurance bill for property liability is due July 1st, which is payment for the first quarter of the year. The amount is \$1,831.25 due on July 1st. Our insurance is through Brotherhood Mutual, the annual premium is \$7,325. Our deductible has increased to \$5,000. Our worker's comp premium is \$476.
- The air duct cleaning in the parsonage was \$1,090.00
- We received \$485 in offering for the parsonage renovations.
- The United Methodist Men has agreed to pay for the cost of the parsonage renovations.
- Payroll has not been paid yet for the month.
- We have \$30,141.17 in the General Fund right now.
- It was agreed that we should pay \$1,767 for one month's worth of Conference Apportionments.

Pastor Mike: (report from Pastor Mike)

 Pastor Mike asked Becky Breeding to present this motion to the Council for approval: to nominate Beth Howdyshell and Alicia Copeland to be At-Large Members of the Administrative Council; and also to nominate Bruce Rogers to be Finance Chairperson through the end of the year. Bill Lalla seconded the motion, and all of these nominations were passed by all present.

Finance Chair: (Bruce Rogers reported)

- Bruce has agreed to be our new Finance Chairperson through the end of 2025.
- Bruce will meet with Pastor HK this upcoming Monday.

Finance Secretary: (Becky Breeding reported)

- Becky is very thankful for her counting team, everything is going well.

Staff Parish Relations Committee: (report from Sandy Wyrick)

- The Parsonage painting went well
- The search for a full-time accompanist is still ongoing. Currently we have Nancy Bassett for the 1st, 3rd and 5th Sundays of the month. And we have Matthew Grandpre for the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month.
- Reminder that we will have a Welcome Luncheon for Pastor Kim and Sarah and that will be Sunday, June 30th.

Trustees: (report from Corey Johnson)

- The plan for the Parsonage turnover and repair was approved. The overwhelming amount of work needed has been mostly completed. The Trustees would like to thank all members of the church for their assistance.
- Further maintenance related problems found in the parsonage that were discovered:
 - Garbage disposal was not working. A new unit has been purchased and installed.
 - Air duct cleaning discovered that there was refuse in the ducting, from household items to rodent remains. Duct cleaning company was able to remove all items, but needed further disinfecting due to the rodent remains for health and safety concerns.
 This increased the overall cost of the project, but the parsonage is now safe for a new baby to crawl and reside in the home.
 - The storm door in the rear of the parsonage was warped and inoperable. The door was removed.
 - The water spicket near the garage was not operational and leaked water from the base of the wall. The spicket is in the process of being replaced.
 - The kitchen sink faucet set needed replacement and was not properly seated into the sink basin. A new faucet set has been purchased and is the process of being replaced.
 - The exposed cable line in the rear of the church has been buried and is back to working order.

- The oak tree in the front of the sanctuary has been ground down, grass seed has been planted, watering will continue until we have a good foundation. Discussion of a replacement/memorial tree has been initiated, suggestions from the congregation are welcome. Other stumps in the rear of the property were also ground down.
- The two metal fence panels that were destroyed from the oak tree falling have been removed in the cemetery.
- The sudden infestation of honeybees in the counting room has been removed. Moth balls were placed in the ceiling and that has driven the colony out. All roof joists in the area have been resealed with new caulking. There has been no further evidence of bees in the area since.
- The door threshold on the exterior door to the social hall has been repaired and repainted.
- The old bell in the front of the social hall has been cleaned and repainted.
- The back row pew in the sanctuary has been moved to the Narthex. The pew is too large to maneuver into any of the classrooms.
- Trustee members are ready for a vacation! LOL

United Methodist Women: (Wanda Harding reported)

- The next women's meeting for the Circle of Hope and the Circle of Love will be on Monday, August 5th at 6pm, for their Family Picnic.

Lay Leader: (Bill Lalla reported)

- We have been averaging about 46 people each Sunday.
- Our Laity is small, but strong, and "we have a good nucleus to start."
- Bill will provide a report of the Annual Conference in the July Hilltopper.

<u>United Methodist Men</u>: (Bill Lalla reported)

- Over the past weeks, the UMM have been working with gardening, weeding, mulching around the church - with much thanks to the women and youth who have also helped with these church chores. They provided the soda, the buns, the hot dogs for Pastor Mike's Farewell Luncheon.
 They have also helped with the parsonage clean-up.
- Bruce Rogers will update our church sign out front with Pastor HK's name on it before Sunday.

Membership: (Karen Whitmer reported)

- The following have recently withdrawn their membership from New Hope United Methodist Church: Blake and Linda McKibbin, Mike and Betty Stout, Jim and Jennifer Strother, Kim and Karen Maugans, Mitch, Samantha, Bianca, Wayne and Russell Brensinger. We wish them God's peace and blessings as they worship with a new church family.

Communications: (Cindy Sheets reported)

- The general computer in the church office has not had its internet access restored yet. We will call John's computer next week to seek help for this issue.

Unfinished Business:

- We are getting quotes on a new gas convection kitchen stove. Bruce will make a spreadsheet to make it easier to compare. The price ranges are \$3,000-\$7,000 of the ones that we are looking at.
- Wanda and Beth are looking to do another fundraiser on August 23rd. It would be Pork BBQ Sandwiches, cole slaw, mac and cheese, green beans. It would be from 4:30pm-6:30pm. There will be a sign-up sheet for volunteers. We will put advertising on the TV3 Community Calendar and on Facebook. The money raised can be used for whatever we need. The cost would be \$12 per dinner. The pork has already been purchased. We will ask the congregation to bring cupcakes for dessert. The event will be dine-in or pickup.
- 50's Drive-In is still planned for September 28th Cindy Sheets and Sandy Wyrick are heading that up.

New Business:

- Our next Community Dinner will be September 4th.
- Alicia said that The Dunns can come on the weekend of November 10th.
- On Sunday, July 21st after worship, we will have a Birthday Bash Luncheon. An event where we will celebrate everyone's birthday at one time. Susan Mehler and Cindy Deavers will head this event. We will ask members of the congregation to bring 12 cakes one for each month/table. This is a covered dish luncheon and the cakes will be provided. Please look for sign-up sheets in the future for those bringing cakes.

- Neither of the bike events that we have had in the past are happening this year due to the Knightly Mill Bridge being repaired. Hopefully next year we can get back on track with those events because they are both excellent fundraisers for us.
- The Music Room has been cleaned, and new shades installed. Thank you to everyone who helped clean and straighten that room. It was noted that we have 25 choir robes available, all are in good condition except two.
- For the month of July, Pastor HK and Sarah will be here all week. For the month of August, they will only be here on weekends, due to Sarah's weekly doctor appointments. When the baby is born, Pastor HK will take a 6 week paternity leave.

Becky Breeding dismissed us with a prayer. The meeting went from 6:32pm-7:34pm

The 242nd session of the Virginia United Methodist Annual Conference took place June 20-22 in Hampton Va.

This was probably the least contentious meeting in many years. Now that COVID is behind us, and (hopefully) we heard the last of disaffiliation, more emphasis is being placed on the church moving forward. There was a service of remembrance for clergy and laity leaders that passed on during the previous 12 months, and there was a service of dedication for laity and clergy alike that were ready to take the next step in their Christian journey.

There were also several thought provoking Christian teaching sessions, which along with the singing were uplifting and inspiring. The conference concluded with a service of consecration where a solemn ceremony of ordination took place.
