The following are the minutes from the <u>MAY</u> meeting of the Administrative Church Council.

The minutes are available to help the entire church family *stay in the know* about how this group is caring for New Hope UMC!

#### Administrative Council Meeting Minutes - May 23, 2024

Present: Becky Breeding, Alicia Copeland, Cindy Deavers, Wanda Harding, Beth Howdyshell, Linda Howdyshell, Laura Jenner, Corey Johnson, Bill Lalla, Susan Mehler, Pastor Mike, Cindy Sheets, Karen Whitmer and Sandy Wyrick.

The meeting was called to order by chairperson Becky Breeding, and Linda read a devotion and prayed.

Sandy made a motion to accept the minutes to last month's meeting, Karen seconded it and it was passed.

#### Finance / Treasurer: (Cindy Deavers reported)

- Since the last council meeting, Cindy D. has sent a check to Weekday Religious Education (WRE) in the amount of \$2500. The dividends received in the gift and memorial fund in the amount of \$1,803.31 and \$696.69 from the local missions fund were used as agreed. (balance sheet will need to be updated)
- The District apportionments have been paid in full. As previously discussed in the last meeting Cindy D. would like to proceed to make a payment for the clergy health (retired and active) in the amount of \$1,767. Cindy D. does not believe this is a problem at this time.
- We collected \$2,367 on the night of the Tenderloin Fundraiser and received additional contributions of \$65. The reimbursements that have been made total \$382.01. Net proceeds as of this date for the fundraiser is \$2,049.99. This money has been deposited in the money market account and are part of the non-designated funds in the gift and memorial fund.
- The proceeds from the Tenderloin Fundraiser will be used to pay the District Missions Asking and make the \$1,767 Retired and Active Clergy Health payment. Cindy D. made a motion to do this and Bill seconded it and it was passed.

- The monthly payroll has not been recorded as of this date. The amount to be disbursed will be
  approximately \$7,244 which includes the lawn service, accompanist, employer match on social
  security, medicare, church's contribution for the pastor health benefits, and the monthly salaries
  for staff.
- Insurance is coming due on July 1st.

#### **Tenderloin Fundraiser:** (Beth Howdyshell reported)

- The fundraiser was very successful, with very high praise for the food. We feel like we can do more in the future. Maybe BBQ Tenderloin sandwiches in the future.
- September 28th 50's Drive-In coming up and hopefully we can bring in money from that.
- In discussions to possibly do some kind of Oyster Dinner this year in the Fall. Would probably have to sell tickets, maybe about 200 tickets or so. Tickets would be around \$25 each, we would serve the people, not help-yourself style. Would offer dine-in and take-out, as about 75% of the profits from the tenderloin dinner was from take-out. Looking to hold this Oyster Fundraiser on November 9th. This gives us alot to think about and discuss.
- We will be getting a new stove for the kitchen from Cavalier Equipment.

#### Pastor Mike: (Pastor Mike reported)

- We are in need of several positions including: Finance Chair, 2 Trustee positions needed, and several positions on the Staff Parish Relations Committee and Nominating Committees. Pastor Mike is trying to fill as many of these positions as possible, so that Pastor HK can come in with full committees ready to go.
- Pastor Mike encouraged all of us to be patient with each other and not to wear ourselves out.

#### **Staff Parish Relations Committee:** (Sandy Wyrick reported)

- The SPRC decided to eliminate the Choir Director position, in order to increase the piano accompanist's position salary, with the hopes of getting more people to apply for the position. They are having trouble finding people who want to play piano in a church. There was one prospect, but he hasn't gotten back with us yet.
- On June 12th at 7pm, we will have a special Charge Conference via Zoom. This is necessary everytime we get a new pastor. All members of the church council and anyone else who wishes are invited to attend. In part, we will be discussing and agreeing to Pastor HK Kim's salary of \$46,000 per year.

- We will have 4 days to paint the interior of the parsonage July 19th-June 22nd. The porch and downstairs bathroom will be done by then. We are in need of anyone who wants to help us paint during that time.
- A new stove for the parsonage will not be needed at this time.
- We will need to move out and store some of the rugs and dining room furniture from the parsonage.
- Pastor HK has gotten quotes from moving companies that range from \$600-\$800.
- On June 26th, Pastor HK will be coming to clean the parsonage, and on June 29th around 3pm-4pm, they will be arriving to move in.
- We will be having a Going Away Picnic for Pastor Mike on Sunday, June 23rd after worship. And we will have a Welcome Reception, with light refreshments, on Sunday, June 30th after worship for Pastor HK and Sarah. Becky Breeding agreed to take the lead on these two events and get help with them. Beth Howdyshell will also help with the food. The United Methodist Men will cook the hot dogs for Pastor Mike's picnic and there will be a covered dish for other items that day.

#### **Trustees:** (Corey Johnson reported)

- The parsonage's porch will be getting cleaned and painted before Pastor HK moves in.
- Also on June 19th, June 20th, June 21st and June 22nd, the inside of the parsonage will be getting painted. Any and all help will be appreciated.
- They have moved the cemetery fund money from a CD at Dupont Community Credit Union to Middlebrook Finance Money Market, another type of investment fund at Dupont Community Credit Union, due to better returns.
- The last pew in the church will be removed, due to it being a trip hazard.

#### **United Methodist Women**: (Wanda Harding reported)

- No women's meetings in June and July.

#### <u>Lay Leader</u>: (Bill Lalla reported)

- We are averaging 43 people each Sunday for worship, which is a solid core of people to work from.
- Bill Lalla will be going to annual conference this year.

#### **United Methodist Men**: (Bill Lalla reported)

- UMM was asked by the ladies of the church to fund, or assist in funding a new stove to replace the existing gas stove. We will be glad to help with this project, but If we were to fund the stove by ourselves, it would leave us with very little in our treasury as we have several other projects on the horizon. We, however, are able to front the entire cost if that is necessary.
- The men have chosen the week of June 1st to have a Saturday morning spring outdoor clean up, I.e. picking up sticks, pruning shrubs, pulling weeds, replacing much, etc.
- The men have also agreed to help with the carry in picnic for Mlke including hot dogs, hamburgers, buns, and soft drinks.
- May was our last official meeting until September.

#### Membership: (Karen Whitmer reported)

- Of all the people who have left our church in the recent past, only one couple have rescinded their membership. Which bears the question: 'Are they finding what they are needing in the wilderness?'

#### **Communications**: (Cindy Sheets reported)

- Working on updating the church website.
- Making instructions for the a/v room

#### **Programming:**

- Cindy Sheets brought up the idea of continuing with Vacation Bible School this summer, possibly
  in July or later in the summer. There was some discussion, then Sandy made a motion not to
  have VBS this year with everything else going on (trying to move one minister in and one
  minister out, etc.), Karen seconded it and it was passed.
- Hosting The Dunns again this year was brought up, it was decided that we will bring that back up when Pastor HK is settled, as he may have some new ideas about musician groups, etc. coming into our church.

#### **New Business:**

- The next meeting will be Thursday June 27th, starting at 6:30pm.

We gathered in a circle together and Becky thanked Alicia for all of her hard work in our music ministry over these past six years. Becky also noted that this was Pastor Mike's last church council with us here at New Hope UMC. She thanked Pastor Mike for everything he has done for us and for seeing us through some unprecedented times in our church's history. Pastor Mike thanked everyone for all they have done over these past years in helping keep the church going through it all.

Pastor Mike dismissed us with a prayer. The meeting went from 6:28pm-7:49pm

For everything there is a season and a time for every matter under heaven:


- a time to be born and a time to die; a time to plant and a time to pluck up what is planted;
